Inpatient:

Our 18-bed inpatient Behavioral Health Unit focuses on crisis stabilization and safety planning intervention. As a psychiatric nurse, you have the unique opportunity to work with patients on the healing of their mind, body, and spirit. Psychiatric nursing offers a wide range of skillset development such as motivational interviewing and traumainformed care. The Behavioral Health team is a multidisciplinary team that includes our psychiatrists, psychiatric nurse practitioners, mental health professionals, nursing staff, and mental health technicians. The Behavioral Health Unit staff begins each day with interdisciplinary team staffing, which is unique from other units. As a psychiatric nurse, you have the ability to spend more one-on-one time with patients in a therapeutic setting that is focused on improvement of interpersonal relationship skills, development of effective coping skills, and crisis planning.

Outpatient:

The Behavioral Health Clinic provides an opportunity to work closely with a psychiatric provider and serve patients living with mental illness. This position allows nursing staff to become more closely connected with their patient population and help support recovery through therapeutic interventions.
